The estate

The Domaine is located in the southern Piedmont of Mont Ventoux in the Comtat Venaissin, on the territory of the Parc Naturel Régional du Ventoux. The vines are in the heart of 8 Ha of Mediterranean woods (pines, olive trees, cedars, green oaks...). 2,7 Ha of red wine. 1.4 Ha of white grape varieties were planted in 2018: Grenache Blanc, Clairette, Roussanne and Rolle.

Etienne and Isabelle Childéric have been creating this estate since 2016.

Terroir

The soil is sandy-clay

Parcels grouped around the estate surrounded by woods.

The vines benefit from a protected environment where biodiversity is rich. The estate benefits from the coolness of the Ventoux with beneficial day/night temperature differences.



Vinification and maturation

Manual harvest.

Aging of 1/3 of the volume for 6 months in barrels of 2 to 3 wines (gentle toasting)

Tasting

Robe: Brilliant with white gold reflections.

Nose: Beautiful aromatic brightness, with notes of citrus zest, star anise, crushed verbena.

Palate: The mouth is straight, tonic, saline.

Alcohol: 12.5% of the volume
